









Stargazer

What You Will Need:

 <p>Paper towel roll</p>	 <p>Pencil</p>	 <p>Scissors</p>	 <p>Flashlight</p>
 <p>Pin</p>	 <p>Black construction paper</p>	 <p>Rubber band or tape</p>	 <p>Ruler</p>

Instructions for Parents/Kids:

1. On a black piece of construction paper take your ruler and trace a square that is three inches long on each side.
2. Trace the rim of the paper towel roll onto the middle of your square with your pencil then use your scissors to cut out the whole square.
3. Inside the circle you just traced, use your pencil to draw different stars in any pattern you choose.
4. Take your pin and poke holes where you drew your stars. Be sure to be careful that you don't rip the paper during this step.
5. Stand up your paper towel roll and line it up with the circle, ensure the opening of the paper towel roll is over the circle of stars.
6. Fold down the extra sides of the paper square and place a rubber band down to secure the sides. To be extra sturdy you can add tape.
7. Shut off the lights in a dark room and place a flashlight on the opposite end of the tube.
8. Point your stargazer up to see the constellation on the ceiling.
