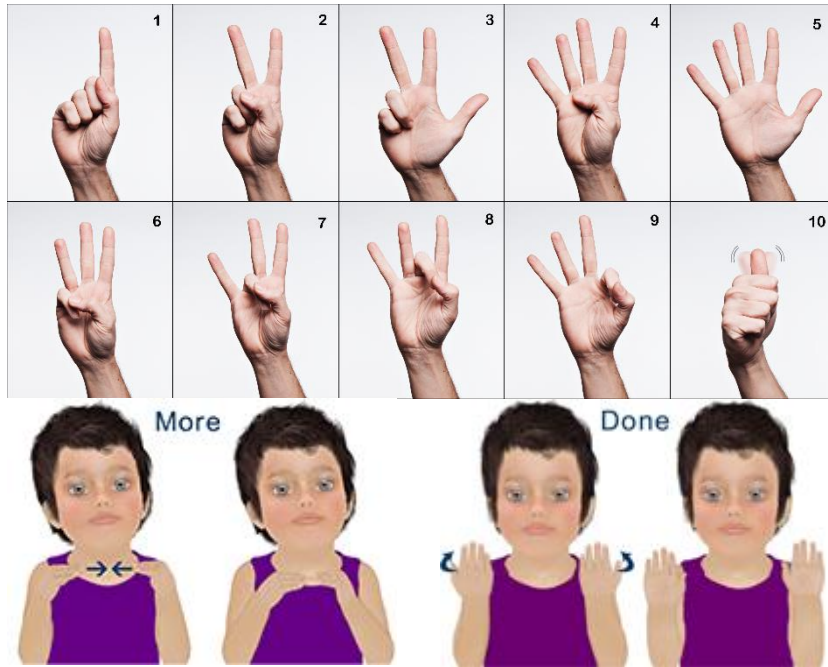


NUMBER GAMES
