

Coralling

Coralling uses one long thread to branch beads off in multiple directions.

1. Cut a thread three feet long.
2. Secure one end.
3. Thread on as many beads as you need to get the length of the finished project.
4. Wrap the thread around the bottom bead, and insert it into the bead above to thread back up.
5. Branch out at any time by pushing the thread out between two beads. Wrap the bottom bead to come back up.
6. Branch off as many times as you desire. Finish by coming back up through the main line of the beads.
