

Amigurumi Coffee Mug Pattern

Materials

- Medium weight yarn in desired color
- Brown medium weight yarn for “coffee”
- A 4 mm crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle
- 2 safety craft eyes
- Fiberfill



Stitches

- Chain stitch
- Single crochet
- Slip stitch

Instructions

Mug

Make a slip knot around your crochet hook and make a chain 6 loop.

Round 1 - Make two single crochet stitches into each stitch. 12 stitches total.

Round 2 - Make a single crochet in the first stitch and two in the next. Repeat all the way around. 18 stitches total.

Round 3 - Make a single crochet stitch in the first two stitches and two in the next stitch. Repeat all the way around. 24 stitches total.

Round 4 - Make a single crochet in the first three stitches and two in the next stitch. Repeat all the way around. 30 stitches total.

Round 5 - Make a single crochet in each stitch around working the back loops only. 30 stitches total. This is what will make the mug shape.

Round 6 - Make a single crochet in each stitch around. 30 stitches total.

Round 7-17 - Repeat round 6

Round 18 - Make a single crochet in the first 29 stitches, make a slip stitch in the next stitch. 30 stitches total. Tie off with this yarn and leave a long tail for sewing later.

Coffee

Using brown yarn, begin this piece the same way you started the mug.

Round 1 - Make two single crochets in each stitch around. 12 stitches total.

Round 2 - Make a single crochet in the first stitch and two in the next. Repeat all the way around. 18 stitches total.

Round 3 - Make a single crochet in the first two stitches and two in the next. Repeat all the way around. 24 stitches total.

Round 4 - Make a single crochet in the first three stitches and two in the next. Repeat all the way around. 30 stitches total.

Round 5 - Make a single crochet in each stitch around. 30 stitches total. Tie off.

Handle

Tie on with mug colored yarn. Make 16 chain stitches.

Row 1 - Make a single crochet in the second chain from the hook and each stitch across. 15 stitches total.

Row 2 - Make a chain stitch to begin the next row. Turn and make a single crochet in each stitch around. 15 stitches total.

Row 3 - Repeat round two. Tie off and leave a tail for sewing.

Assembly

1. Position the eyes on the front of the mug and attach them in place. Sew a small mouth onto the mug with the brown yarn.
2. Stuff the center of the mug with fiber fill. Place the coffee on top of the filling. Use the tail from the mug to sew the coffee inside the mug.
3. Position the handle on the side of the mug. Sew the handle in place on the top and bottom.
4. Weave in all ends and cut the tails.
