

Crocheted Granny Square Sling Purse Pattern

This shoulder bag is made by crocheting two granny squares together, then adding a liner and a handle.

Materials and Tools Needed

One ball each of four different colored, medium weight, cotton yarns
5mm crochet hook
Scissors
Yarn needle
Button (optional)

Stitches Used

Slipknot
Chain stitch
Slipstitch
Double crochet
Half double Crochet



Purse Pattern

Granny Square (make 2)

Tie a slipknot in the end of the first color yarn. Make six chain stitches and join them together to form a loop.

Round 1 - Chain 2 to begin the round. Make three double crochet stitches into the loop for the side. Make two chain spaces for a corner. Make a total of four sides and four corners to form a square. Join the end of the round with a slipstitch.

Round 2 - Chain 2 to begin the round. Make a double crochet in each double crochet from the previous round until you reach a corner. In the corner make a double crochet into the space, chain 2 and make another double crochet into the same space. Repeat around the square and end with a slipknot.

Round 3 - Tie off the previous color and add on a second color. Repeat round 2.

Round 4 - Repeat round 2

Round 5 - Repeat round 3

Round 6 - Repeat round 2 and tie off last color.

Make the Liner

Tie a slipknot with fourth color yarn. Make 22 stitches to begin the liner.

Round 1 - Make a half double crochet stitch in the third chain from the hook and each stitch across.

Round 2 - Make two chain stitches to begin the round. Make a half double crochet in each stitch around.

Rounds 3-30 - Repeat round 2, tie off leaving a long tail.

Purse Handle

Tie a slipknot with the first color yarn you used. Make 182 double crochet stitches.

Round 1 - Make a half double crochet stitch in the third stitch and each stitch across. Tie off with this color.

Round 2 - Tie on with the second color yarn. Make two chain stitches to begin row and make a half double crochet stitch in each stitch across. Tie off.

Round 3 - Repeat round 2 with the third color yarn.

Assembly

1. Hold the two granny squares together and tie on with the first color yarn. Attach the square together on three sides by single crocheting in each stitch around, going through both squares. Make four stitches in the corners. Tie off when you have stitched up all three sides. Cut the ends and weave in the tails.

2. Fold the liner in half so it fits inside the granny squares. Use the tail you left to sew the liner together across the sides and bottom so it has the top open. Cut the ends and weave in the tails.

3. Cut the ends and weave in the tails of the handle.

4. Place the liner inside the granny squares. Fold the edges of the liner over the edge of the granny squares. Hold one end of the liner up on the side of the pouch over the liner. Sew the handle to the pouch in a square pattern sewing through both the liner and the granny square. Repeat on the other side of the pouch to attach the other end of the handle.
