

Center Beaded Bracelet

Materials:

- Embroidery thread in desired color
- 6 beads
- 3mm crochet hook
- Scissors

Stitches Used:

- Chain stitch
- Single crochet
- Half double crochet
- Single crochet with a bead: Go through a stitch, yarn over above bead, pull through stitch, yarn over, and pull through all loops.



Instructions:

1. Make a slip knot in the end of the end of the thread. Make 51 chain stitches.
2. Turn, make a single crochet in the second chain from hook, and next nine stitches. Make a half double crochet in the next 30 stitches, and a single crochet in the last ten stitches. Tie off thread.
3. Cut a new piece of thread measuring three feet long. Thread all the beads onto the thread and tie a loose knot in one end to hold them on. Tie a slip knot in the other end of the thread and insert your hook. Make a slip stitch into the first stitch of the previous round of the bracelet. Make a single crochet around a bead for the first stitch. Make a regular single crochet in the next four stitches, then one around a bead. Repeat until you come to the last half double crochet of the previous round. Untie the loose knot in the end of the thread and continue using the same piece for the next row.
4. Make a chain stitch and turn in the opposite direction. Make a half double crochet in each stitch across. The bead row will now be the center of the bracelet. When you reach the end of the bead row, tie off. Cut the thread ends.
5. Wear the bracelet by tying it around your wrist.
