

Painted White Paper Roses


In *Alice in Wonderland*, Alice encounters three playing card suitors who are busy painting white roses red. They've been ordered to complete this nonsensical sounding task by the Queen of Hearts.

You can make your own fairy tale inspired roses from white paper and red watercolor paint.

Cut a large circle shape from your paper. Trace a spiral pattern along the circle and cut it out.



Starting at the outermost spiral, coil the paper around the end of a pencil.



When you get to the inner part of the spiral, carefully slip the spiraled paper off the pencil. Let it uncoil as desired, then hot glue the bottom together to keep it secure.

Use red watercolors to add a touch of color to your paper rose. Glue the rose to green paper leaves, if desired.
