

## **Crochet Edging With Loops**

This pattern makes a wonderful border for clothing and accessories.

## **Tools and Materials:**

- 5 mm crochet hook
- Yarn needle
- Scissors
- Worsted weight yarn in desired color(s)

## Abbreviations:

- Sc Single crochet
- · Ch Chain stitch
- Dc Double crochet
- Ss Slip Stitch



## Instructions:

Start out by making a row of Sc stitches all around your work. This looks best when done using the same color as your work. After doing one row of Sc, switch to your desired color for your border and begin following the pattern below. Work in rows.

- 1. Sc in first stitch. Ch 5 times. Skip 1 stitch and Sc in next. One loop created. Continue all around your work.
- 2. Switch colors if desired. Ss in first skipped stitch from previous round. Ch 2 (counts as first Dc) make 2 Dc in same stitch. Make 3 Dc in next skipped stitch from the previous round. Repeat all the way around your work. Ss in top of the first Dc. Tie off yarn, cut and weave in ends.
