

Crocheted Net-Lace Shawl

Abbreviations:

- sl st = slip stitch
- ch = chain
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- tr = treble crochet
- sk = skip

Things You Will Need:

- 2 Red Heart Super Saver, Worsted Weight-Medium Thyme
- H-Hook
- Scissors
- Measuring tape

Finished Size: 14" x 70"



Note: This crochet pattern does not include a gauge as it is not a pattern that requires a sized fit, however, adjustments can be made to achieve a finished shawl with measurements the same as the pattern's finished size. The beginning ch measures 23" long. Add or subtract chs in multiples of four to produce the same measurement.

Shawl Body

Row 1: Ch 84. Sl st in 8th ch from the hook. *sk 3 chs, sl st in next ch, ch 4.* Repeat between ** to the end of the ch. Sl st in the last ch.

Row 2: Turn. Ch 4, sl st in the first ch loop of the previous row. *Ch 4, sl st in the next ch loop.* Repeat between the ** to the end of the row. (20 loops)

Remaining Body Rows: Repeat Row 2 until the body measures 64" long.

When body measures 64" long, do not finish off, do not turn.

Edging

Continue the next stitches along the side of the shawl, across the end, up the other side and across the last end.

Hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc (cluster) in the first loop on the side. Sl st around the first sl st of the previous row.
Cluster in the next loop, sl st around next sl st of previous row. Continue around the body. Sl st to the beginning of the first cluster. Finish off and weave in the end.
