

Crocheted 18-Inch Doll Shirt

Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half-double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- sk = skip
- st(s) = stitch(es)

Special Stitch:

Dc cluster-2 dc in each of two sts

Things You Will Need:

- Worsted weight yarn-Red Heart (Baby Pink)
- G-hook
- Scissors
- 3/8" white flat buttons (5)



Gauge: 9 dc = 2", 2 dc rows = 1"

Shirt

Rnd 1: Note - This step is worked in the round. Sc in second ch from hook, *2 dc in next ch, sc in next*, Repeat from * to * to the end of the ch. Sc in the same ch as the last sc. Turn to work up the back of the ch. *2 hdc in the next ch, hdc in next*. Repeat from * to *, ending with 2 hdc in the last ch. The back of the ch is the working row and ends with 35 hdc. Turn.

Note - Remaining steps are worked in rows.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Dc in the first two sts, dc cluster, *dc in 7, dc cluster*. Repeat from * to * two times. Dc in last three. Turn. (43 dc)

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Dc in first three sts, *dc cluster, dc in 9*. Repeat from * to * two times. Dc in the last four. Turn. (51 dc)

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Dc in first four, *dc cluster, dc in 11*. Repeat from * to * two

times. Dc in last five. (59 dc)

Row 5: (Arm Holes) Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Dc in first six, ch 5, sk 15 sts, dc in 15, ch 5, sk 15, dc in last seven. Turn. (29 dc, 10 ch)

Row 6: Ch 3 (counts as first dc). Dc in every dc and ch. Turn. (39 dc)

Row 7: Ch 1 (counts as first sc). Ch 1, sk next st, sc in next*. Repeat from * to * across. Turn.

Row 8: Ch 3, 3 dc in each ch 1 sp across, dc in the top of beginning ch (first sc) of previous row. Turn.

Row 9: Ch 3, sk a st, *2 dc in next, sk a st*. Repeat from * to * across. Dc in the top of beginning ch (first dc) of previous row. Turn.

Row 10: Ch 3, 2 dc in first ch sp. 3 dc in each ch sp across to last sp. 2 dc in last ch sp, dc in the top of beginning ch (first dc) of previous row. Turn.

Row 11: Ch 1, *sc, 2 dc in next*. Repeat from * to * across. Sc in last two sts. Do not fasten off.

Button Placket

Note: The placket is worked in the ends of the rows.

Row 1: Ch 2 (counts as first hdc). Evenly space 20 hdc in the ends of rows up to the working side of Rnd 1. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 2. Hdc in each st. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Attach the yarn to the end of Row 11 on the opposite end of the shirt rows. Repeat placket Rows 1 and 2.
