

Knitted Fingerless Gloves



Abbreviations

- K – Knit
- P – Purl

Materials Needed

- Yarn – Purl Essence Sincerely Oatmeal Heather acrylic yarn, 1 ball.
- Knitting needles – size US 8, 5 mm
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

*The size of the gloves will depend on how tight or loose you make the stitches.

Instructions

Cast on 31 stitches.

Row 1 – *K1, P1, repeat from * across.

Row 2 – Begin stockinette stitch, knit across.

Row 3 – Purl across.

Row 4 – Repeat row 2.

Row 5 – Repeat row 3.

Continue repeating row 2 and row 3 until the rectangle is 7 inches long.

Final row – Bind off, leave about a 20-inch tail to sew the glove together.

Finishing – Use the yarn tail and yarn needle to stitch both sides of the rectangle together. Leave about a 2-inch hole in the seam for your thumb. Whipstitch along the thumb area. Do not cut the yarn until the seam is completed. Finish off ends by weaving through the stitches on the inside of the glove.
