

## Crochet Butterfly Magnet / Ornament



### Things You Will Need:

- Worsted weight yarn
- H-crochet hook
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Craft magnet (optional)
- Craft glue

### Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- st(s) = stitches
- dc = double crochet
- sc = single crochet
- sl st = slip stitch
- rnd = round
- sp = space

### Special Note:

Work in continuous rnds. Do not join.

Form a magic ring. Work sts in the ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as first dc, now and throughout), 2 dc, ch 1. \*3 dc, ch 1 (cluster)\* Repeat from \* to \* 6 more times. Sl st to top of beginning ch 3. Pull the tail to cinch the center closed. (8 clusters)

**Rnd 2:** Sl st in next 2 sts and into ch1 sp. (Ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1) in the same ch 1 sp. \*3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 1\* in next ch 1 sp and each sp around. Sl st to top of beginning ch 3.

**Rnd 3:** Sl st in next 2 sts and into the first ch 2 sp. Ch



3, 8 dc in the ch 2 sp, sc in ch 1 sp. \*9 dc in next ch 2 sp, sc in ch 1 sp.\* Repeat from \* to \* around. Sl st to top of beginning ch 3. DO NOT fasten off.

### **Finishing**

**Step 1:** Ch 12.

**Step 2:** Fold the butterfly in half with the wrong sides together and the ch centered on the edge opposite the fold.

**Step 3:** Wind the ch around the center. Sl st to the beginning of the ch. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

**Step 4:** Cut a 4" strand of yarn. Insert the strand under the ch at the top of the butterfly. Tie the ends together in a knot to form the antenna.

**Step 5:** Glue a magnet to the back or thread a loop of yarn to the top to create a hanger.
