

# **Crochet Pansy**



# Things You Will Need:

- · Worsted weight yarn, purple, yellow and navy blue
- G-crochet hook
- Scissors
- · Yarn needle

#### Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- st(s) = stitches
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- sp = space
- sl st = slip stitch
- rnd(s) = round

#### **Finished Size:**

- 3" diameter
- A gauge is not necessary with this pattern as it does not require a sized fit.

## **Special Note:**

Flower is worked in continuous rnds. Do not ch up at the beginning of rnds.

#### **Bottom Petals**

With purple, form a magic ring.

Rnd 1: \*Ch 4, sc\* 3 times in the ring. Pull the tail to close the center.

Rnd 2: \*Sc, hdc, 5 dc, hdc\* in each ch 4 sp of the previous rnd.

Rnd 3: \*Sc, hdc, 2 dc in next five sts, hdc.\* Repeat from \* to \* around.

Rnd 4: SI st in each st around. Fasten off and weave in ends.



## **Top Petals**

With yellow, form a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** \*Ch 3, sc\* 3 times in the ring. Pull the tail to close the center.

Rnd 2: \*Sc, hdc, 5 dc, hdc\* in each ch 3 sp of the previous rnd.

Rnd 3: SI st in each in each st around. Fasten off and weave in the ends.



### **Finishing**

**Step 1:** Thread a yarn needle with a double strand of navy blue yarn.

**Step 2:** Stack the petals, centering the yellow on the purple.

**Step 3:** \*Insert the needle from the back to the front through the center. Cross over the center of one ch 3 space and insert the needle on the bottom edge of Rnd 2. Pull through to the back. Repeat two more sts beside the first, over the same ch 3 sp.\* Repeat from \* to \* on the remaining ch 3 spaces. Fasten off on the back and weave in the ends.
