

Crochet Daffodil



Things You Will Need:

- Worsted weight yarn, yellow and orange
- G-crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- st(s) = stitches
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- trc = treble crochet
- bl = back
- lps = loops
- rem = remaining
- sp(s) = space
- sl st = slip stitch
- rnd(s) = round

Finished Size:

- 3 1/4" diameter
- A gauge is not necessary with this pattern as it does not require a sized fit.

Petals

With yellow, form a magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (counts as first dc). 8 dc in the ring. Sl st to the top of beginning ch 2. Pull the tail to close the center. (9 dc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1. Working in the bl only, 2 sc in each st around. Sl st to beginning ch 1. (18 sc)

Rnd 3: Sc in first st. *2 trc in next st, ch 2, sl st in second ch from hook, 2 trc in next st, sc in next.* Repeat from * to * around. End with a sc. Fasten off and weave in the ends. (6 petals)



Trumpet (Daffodil Cup)

Rnd 1: Attach yellow to any rem loop on Rnd 2 of petals. Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in each remaining loop around. Sl st to beginning ch 2. (9 dc)

Rnd 2: Sc in same st as join. *Ch 3, sc in next st.* Repeat from * to * around. End with ch 3. Sl st in first sc of round. Fasten off and weave in the ends. (9 ch 3 sps)



Stigma

Step 1: With orange, ch 5. 2 sc in second ch from hook, sl st in the remaining chs. Fasten off with a tail for sewing.

Step 2: Thread the tail on a yarn needle. Insert the needle down through the center of the trumpet. Knot the yarn on the bottom of the flower and fasten off. Weave in ends.
