

Crochet Poinsettia



Things You Will Need:

- Worsted weight yarn, red and yellow
- G-crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- st(s) = stitches
- sc = single crochet
- hdc = half double crochet
- dc = double crochet
- trc = treble crochet
- rem = remaining
- sl st = slip stitch
- rnd = round

Finished Size:

- 8 1/2" diameter
- A gauge is not necessary with this pattern as it does not require a sized fit.

Special Notes:

- Each petal has one rnd with multiple changing stitches. Pattern is written with ordered list of sts per ch.
- Petals are worked on both sides of the beginning ch.
- After last ch you will work back on the opposite side in unworked loops of beginning ch.

Large Petals (make 6)

With red, ch 18.

Sl st in second ch from hook and in next two chs.

Sc

Hdc

Dc in next three chs.

Trc in next five chs.

Dc

Hdc

Sc

In Last Ch: Sc, ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from hook, sc.

Sc

Hdc

Dc

Trc in next five chs

Dc in next three chs

Hdc

Sc

Sl st in next three chs. This is the bottom of the petal.

Fasten off leaving a tail on one petal for sewing. Weave in ends on all other petals.

Small Petals (make 5)

With red, ch 11.

Sl st in second ch from hook and in the next ch.

Sc

Dc

Trc in next three chs.

Dc

Hdc

In Last Ch: Sc, Ch 4, sl st in 4th ch from the hook, sc.

Hdc

Dc

Trc in next three chs.

Dc

Sc

Sl st in next two chs. This is the bottom of the petal.

Fasten off leaving a tail on one petal for sewing. Weave in ends on all other petals.

Finishing:

Step 1: Thread the tail of the one large petal that was left with a tail for sewing. Insert the needle across the bottom of each rem large petal. Slide them tightly together. Stitch to the first petal and fasten off and weave in the end.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 with the small petals. Do not fasten off.

Step 3: Center the small petals on top of the large petals. Stitch through the center to attach both layers. Fasten off and weave in the end.

Step 4: Thread yellow yarn on the yarn needle. Working through all layers, stitch three French knots in the center of the flower.
