

Locker Caddy

Your child can make a personalized locker caddy to keep her locker neat and organized.

Supplies

- Small cardboard box (like a Pop-Tart box)
- Con-tact paper (any color)
- Scrap pieces of cardboard
- Scissors or knife
- Strong magnetic strips (optional)



Instructions

1. Take a small cardboard box and wrap it with Con-Tact
2. Make dividers by cutting two pieces of heavy cardboard the same width as the box
3. Wrap these pieces to match the rest of the box
4. Cut a slit down the middle of one, leaving an inch or two uncut. Cut a short slit, about two inches long, into the other piece.
5. Slide the two pieces together so the slits fit inside one another, and slide them into the box
6. Add an adhesive-backed strong magnet or two if you want to hang the box, or just leave it to sit on the floor or shelf of the locker
7. Fill with pencils, hairbrushes, and other important supplies.
