

# Decoupage Collage

You can also create a decoupage collage cover for a notebook or three ring binder. This provides the perfect way for kids to display pictures featuring their favorite people, places, and things. Young kids might like a collage of family pictures, while older kids would like to use pictures of themselves hanging out with their friends. This is a fun way to keep summer memories close as the school year begins.

## Supplies

- Copies of old photos
- Wrapping paper or patterned scrapbook paper
- Other images such as Sunday comics, old maps, sheet music or images from favorite magazines
- Mod Podge adhesive
- Foam paint brush
- Notebook or binder



## Instructions

1. Cut out the images you wish to use, playing with the arrangement on a sheet of scratch paper
2. Apply Mod Podge to the images using a foam paint brush
3. Adhere the images to the notebook or three-ring binder, carefully smoothing out the paper to prevent air bubbles when the Mod Podge dries
4. When the Mod Podge is completely dry, cover the surface with one or two more coats of Mod Podge to seal and protect your project.
