

# Making a Synonym 'Mittens' Game

## **Lesson Objectives**

#### Student will:


- Learn that a synonym is a word that is similar to another word.
- Learn common synonyms for words by playing 'mad libs'


### Materials:

- Colored pencils, stickers, markers, etc.
- Cardstock

#### Directions:

- 1. Print out the mittens on stiff paper, such as card stock.
- 2. Have your child cut out the mittens.
- 3. Once all the mittens are cut out, have her pair each mitten with its synonym.
- 4. Consider having her color or decorate synonym pairs the same way to reinforce the idea visually. For example, 'bad' and 'evil' might both have green polka dots.
- 5. There are blank mittens for additional words and word suggestions at the end. Once she has the idea of synonyms down, have her start creating her own pairs.
